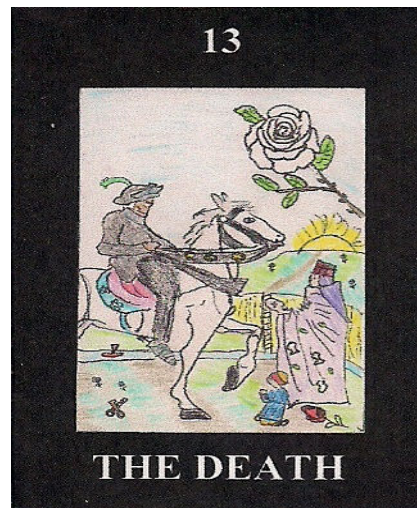

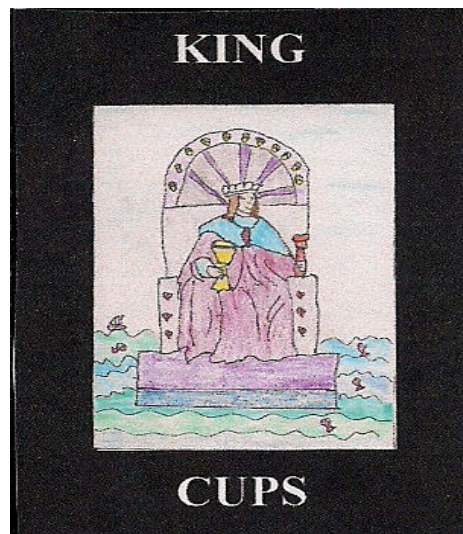

With every birth, a soul is born, and with this soul, there is a name. Every name given at birth contains all the tools and talents that we can use in this lifetime.

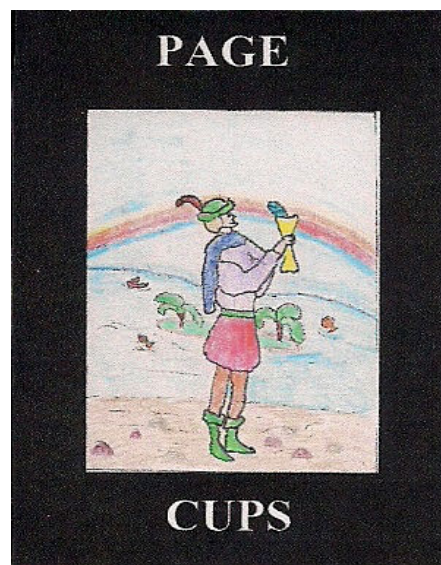

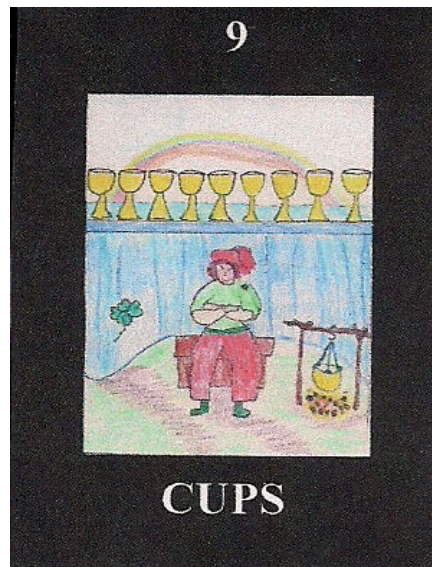

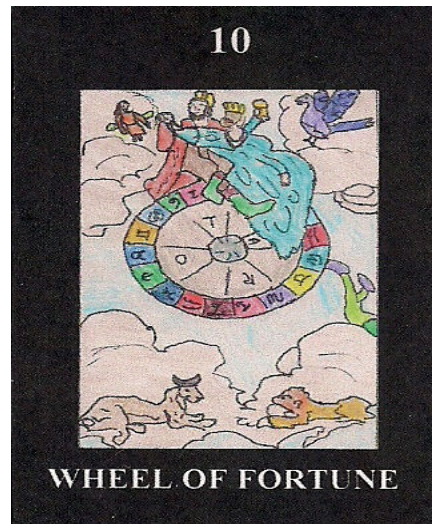
The Nine of Cups

It is known in the Greek Mythology, that there were three women that are known as the fates. They were responsible for spinning the destiny of each person at his or her time of birth.

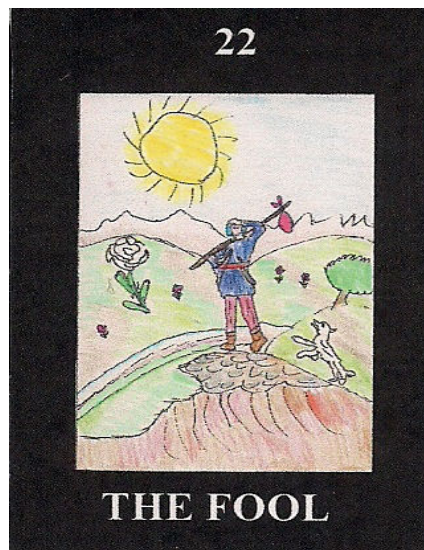

In the medieval courts, the king's fool or jest was someone who was not expected to follow the same rules as everyone else as he was unpredictable and full of surprises.

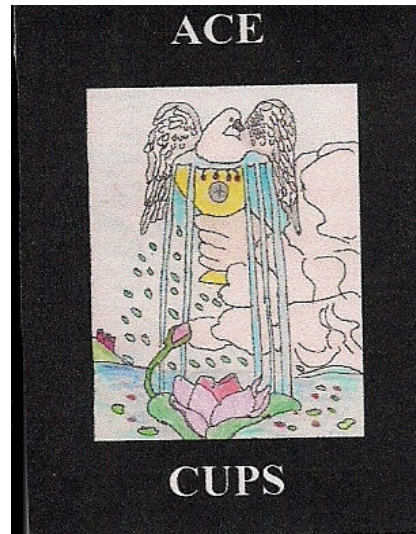

The Ace of cups is about love, compassion, partnership, feelings, intuition.

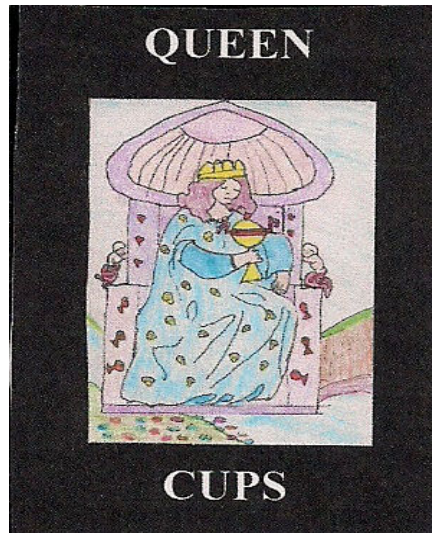

As we look at the picture, we can see a young man and young woman pledging their love for each other. In the air above them floats the caduceus of Hermes, surrounded by a winged lion head.

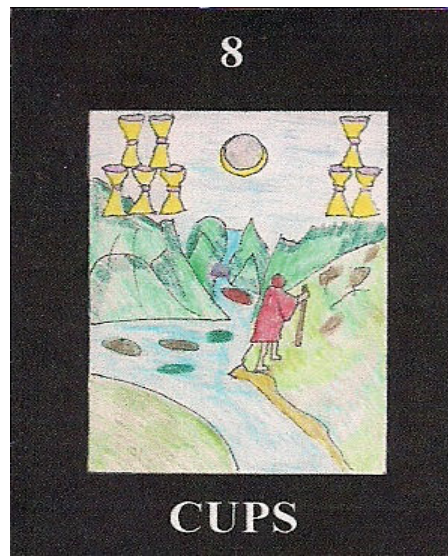

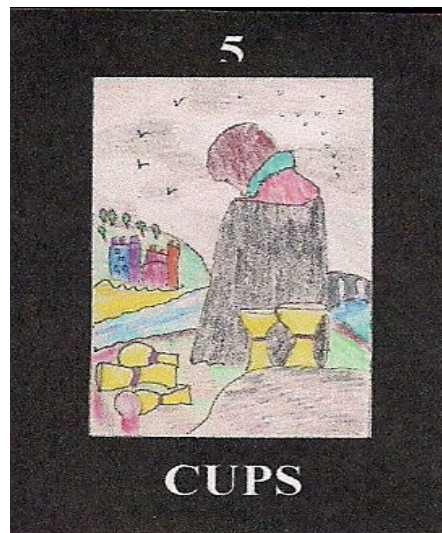

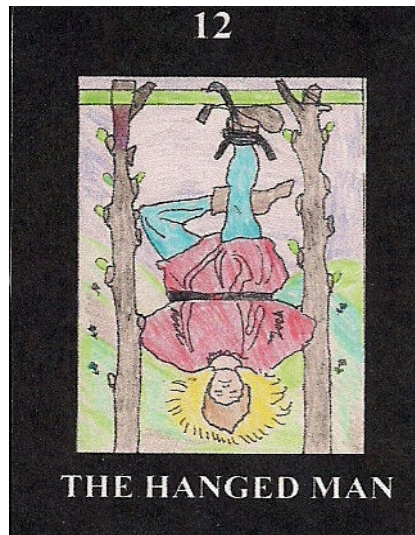
